The Grout Museum District Board has been fortunate to have had the guidance and support of many community leaders. This past year saw the loss of four of these individuals, but each, in his or her own way, left behind a wealth of wisdom and history that is evident yet today.

Roger Olesen chaired the board and along with Edward J. Gallagher led the effort that resulted in the addition of the Sullivan Brothers Iowa Veterans Museum. From securing a major donation from the Board to overseeing the construction and grand opening, Roger and Ed, both WWII veterans, helped create a community asset that impacts the entire state.

Helen Guernsey and H. D. "Ike" Leighty supported the science side of the Grout's mission. Helen's support of the Outreach Program (through the Max and Helen Guernsey Foundation) ensures that the Grout's ability to ignite curiosity and connect with young people can take place beyond the walls of the Bluedorn Science Imaginarium. Ike shared his love of science and experimenting through the support of science programming and the STEM festival.

The Cedar Valley is fortunate that the passion and dedication of these four individuals is preserved at the Grout Museum District.



LEGACY OF LEARNING

Carol Houk's legacy is the love of learning. After teaching in the Waterloo School system for 37 years, Carol transferred her teaching skills to the Grout Museum District's Museum School Program. One of her colleagues at the Grout reminisced about Carol and her Museum School students: I always remember the kids commenting on her petite stature. She was only about a couple inches taller than the students, especially in the spring months. They got the biggest kick out of it, but she always made sure they knew that she was in charge. Carol personalized the immigration tour, sharing with the students her personal memories of the Waterloo she knew as a third grader. The students loved Carol and she is deeply missed by all at the Grout Museum District.




